Conditions for Participation (Please read carefully)

I confirm that my child/ward:

- Is 14 years or older on 25th April 2020 and has completed Stages 1 - 4 of the Junior Sailing Programme.
- Is a confident swimmer and can swim at least 25 meters without a buoyancy aid.
- Is, to the best of my knowledge, fit to take part in this Course.
- If you believe your child may require some special consideration i.e. has any disability or medical condition (including dietary needs), please indicate this by ticking this box. You will then be asked to complete a detailed medical form so that accurate and relevant medical information can be provided which may be shared with the course instructors and volunteer helpers.
- If selected, will be able to attend the full 2 days of Assistant Instructor (AI) training and assist in the thirteen sessions of the course on Saturday mornings from 25th April to 18th July (sickness apart) and that should my child be unable to attend a particular session, I shall inform the Junior Sailing Coordinator at least 24 hours before that session.
- I understand that RDYC JS's supervisory responsibility for my child/ward commences when my child/ward signs the Attendance Register at the beginning of a training session and ceases when my child/ward signs the Attendance Register at the end of the training session. RDYC JS Staff are normally in attendance from 09.30 to 12.30. Supervision outside normal times must be by prior arrangement with the Principal or Senior Instructor.
- I understand that whilst all instructors, safety boat crews and other persons involved with RDYC JS will take all reasonable care, there remains an element of risk in sailing and related water activities. I therefore accept the limitations of the RDYC's liability for sailing activities as defined by the RDYC Rules and Constitution (a copy of which is available on the Club website and Club noticeboard. I acknowledge that it is a condition of the RDYC insurance that RYA Senior Instructors or RYA Coaches do not accept responsibility for any loss, damage or injury suffered by persons and/or their property arising out of or during the course of their activities whilst training and/or coaching and/or instructing unless such injury, loss or damage was caused by, or resulted from, negligence or deliberate act.

Photography

In accordance with our child protection policy we will not arrange for photographs, video or other image of young people to be taken without the consent of the parents/guardians and children.
