Facilities

Showers and toilettes are available in the RDYC and Dartmouth Yacht Clubs. Toilettes are also available in Royal Avenue Gardens (just by the Double Steps landing.

Shopping is plentiful. There are two supermarkets in the town, Marks and Spencers (0830-1900 except Sunday 1000-1600) and the Coop (Every day 0700-2200). Lidl and Sainsbury are accessible by bus in the upper part of town.

Eating Ashore is also well served by many restaurants and Pubs. Booking is recommended especially Friday and Saturday.

Hospitals - The nearest hospital is Torbay on the west side of Torquay (about 20 mins from Kingswear) by car.

Chandlery is available from Darthaven Marina and also Dartmouth Home & Hardware Ltd (not Sundays). There are many suppliers of engineering and general repairs.
