

Corinthian Class Racing Procedures

PURSUIT RACE PROCEDURE

1. Race duration

- 1.1 Wednesday race duration will be 75 minutes for the scratch boat.
- 1.2 Saturday race duration will be 120 minutes for the scratch boat.

2. Start Times

2.1 Entrants will be allocated a start time based on their RYA YTC handicap. Since Wednesday and Saturday races are different durations, they will have Wednesday and Saturday start times.

3. Race Control

- 3.1 The Duty Boat may decide that conditions are unsuitable for racing and cancel or abandon racing.
- 3.2 The Duty Boat will announce the course at least 10 minutes before the first start.

4. Sailing the Course

- 4.1 Yachts will start at, or after, their start time.
- 4.2 Yachts will sail the designated course until the duty boat announces that the race has finished.

5. Finishing Position

- 5.1 When the race is complete, yachts shall note sail numbers of the boat behind and the boat in front and also record their GPS position and number of crew. This data to be communicated on the 'Corinthian Racing' WhatsApp group.
- 5.2 If there is doubt over a position, the distance to the next mark shall be used.

ELAPSED TIME RACE PROCEDURE

1. Starting Window

1.1 The Starting Window opens for ten minutes at the time shown in the Corinthian Racing Programme. Yachts must start during this period.

2. Finish Times

2.1 Yachts shall report their elapsed time and number of crew on the 'Corinthian Racing' WhatsApp group.

3. Race Control

- 3.1 The Duty Boat may decide that conditions are unsuitable for racing and cancel or abandon racing.
- 3.2 The Duty Boat will announce the course at least 30 minutes before the starting window opens.
